



THE DESIGN PROCESS

2022 THEME: OUT OF THIS WORLD

CONCEPT AND GOALS FOR “THE GALAXY GIRLS”

Involve the girls as much as possible, from initial designs to music to their dance moves. Kids are what ChildServe is all about! (Plus, they’re adorable.)

Concept: A glamorous alien lands near five space girls. Is she friendly? Is she evil? These brave girls need to find out! They follow her until she has completely landed. Look! She’s wearing a peace sign and carrying flowers! She’s here to spread peace and love throughout the galaxy.

Materials: Bubble wrap and lots of hot glue and duct tape.

Yes, you can sew bubble wrap—and we did.

Building the Spaceship

- Start with a clear umbrella
- Do some math and measuring
- Cut and join the body panels made from Double Bubble Reflective Thermal Aluminum Foil Radiant Heat Vapor Barrier Insulation (aka stiff silver bubble wrap)—but don't attach the panels to the umbrella or it won't fit in your car
- Add a bottom band and tape it all together just before showtime




The final touches: Remote control lights and a star-studded antenna



(If you don't pick your own name, your mom and the little girls will find one for you)



A long platinum wig, silver leggings, great make-up, and killer shoes completed her ensemble.




DETAILS
