

Pattern for Folding Fabric Travel Box

Supplies needed:

Fabric: 2 9" squares of fabric with coordinating thread

Heavy weight Interfacing (70): 4 3/8" x 10 7/8"

Snaps: 4 pair of snaps (size 15, 3/8" or 9 mm)

Cutting Instructions:

- Cut two pieces of fabric: 9" square (3/8" seams).
Finished box will be 8.25" square
- Cut one piece of interfacing: 4 3/8" x 4 3/8" (square)
- Cut four pieces of interfacing: 1 5/8" x 4 3/8" (rectangle)

Sewing Instructions:

1. Place good sides of two pieces of fabric together and sew seam on three sides using a 3/8" seam allowance.
2. Turn inside out, so that good sides are out.
3. Top stitch 1/8" from edge on three sides.
4. Stitch 1 7/8" from edge on both sides to create sides of box.
5. Slide in rectangular interfacing in center top of box.
6. Stitch 1 7/8" from top of box.
7. Slide in rectangular interfacing on sides of box and square interfacing in center of box.
8. Stitch 2 1/4" from unfinished end of box.
9. Slide in rectangular interfacing in center of unfinished box.
10. Fold under 3/8" seam allowance and pin.
11. Top stitch 1/8" from edge of fabric to finish box.
12. Install snaps at four corners of box where there is no interfacing. Snaps should connect on inside surface of box.
